CAUTION: Store in the dark at 36° to 45°F (2° to 7°C). Do not freeze. Warm to 72°F (22°C) and shake well before using. Do not vaccinate within 42 days before slaughter. Use entire contents when first opened.

Gentamicin and amphotericin B added as preservatives.
